This week:

In Maths, we have continued with adding with partitioning as well as playing with out partitioning. If we know 97 is made up of $90 + 7$ then we also know its made up of:

$$80 + 17 = 70 + 27 = 60 + 37 = 50 + 47 = 40 + 57 = 30 + 67 = 20 + 67 = 10 + 77 = 0 + 97.$$

In English, Crystal Class have been learning about adjectives. This has helped us to write descriptions of our settings for our superhero stories. We have been considering words other than colours to help challenge our vocabulary further.

In our projects, we have looked at 3D models and how to make the frames for our superhero cars. The children needed a lot of problem-solving skills for this and it has introduced them to the idea of nets which they will learn about later in school life.



Using our Science knowledge of everyday materials, the children have investigated and recorded results for a science investigation where the children had to find the stretchiest material for Elastogirls costume. The children then wrote conclusions from what they found.
