We started off the week with a lovely Harvest festival in the Church. The children sang beautifully, and it was a lovely service hosted by our new Vicar.

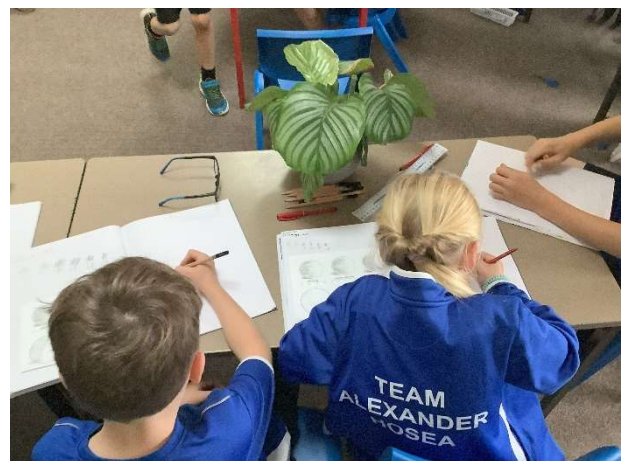
