Writing an alternative ending to a narrative

Multiplying 2 digit by 1 digit numbers. 17 x 4, 14 x 3, 16 x 8, 15 x 2 this will then build to bigger numbers throughout the year such as 64 x 3.

Way to support at home (home learning)

Discuss the story at home with the children, what other things could the medicine have done?

Practice breaking numbers up for example (17 x 4) 17 = 10 + 7

Then you would do 10 x 4 and 7 x 4 and add the two answers together.
