## **Things to note:**

We are having a real push with our Times Tables Rock Stars at the moment as tables are such an important part of maths. It would be wonderful if you could encourage your child to practise on there each night. It only needs to be about 5 minutes each evening but it would make a difference.

## **This week:**

In Maths, we have been working on our addition methods. We have looked at adding within twenty and then we continued to add single digit numbers to 2 digit numbers, crossing over the 10. In order to do this, we had to be careful to make sure that our counting up to 100 was accurate. Once we had achieved this, we then started looking at adding using the partitioning method. This is still something we are working on.

In English, we have been learning to sequence our sentences and we have been learning how to accurately punctuate each sentence. This is something we will continue to practise over the year as it can be complicated. We have also been looking at how to identify and write questions. This was very helpful from when we had a visit from the local Police. The class were full of fascinating questions. Well done Crystal Class.

In our projects, we have been learning about chronology as we are beginning to look at real-life heroes from the past. We started by chronologically sequencing events in our lives.
