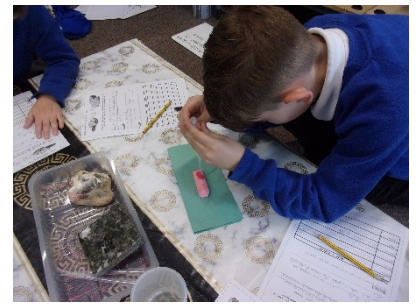

# Crystal Class Newsletter

In science we have had a great time investigating rocks. We have carried out a scratch test to see how durable different types of rocks are and a water test to see which rocks are permeable and impermeable.



In maths our focus is on money. We have identified coins and their value and have begun to add amounts of money together. We will be moving on to subtracting one amount from another and linking both to calculating change.



In English, we are continuing to use the 'Stone Age Boy' text to help us develop our writing skills. We have been learning about the past tense and the present perfect tense.
