

Date of project: Terms 3 and 4

A history led project which will begin by broadening our understanding of chronology and where the Ancient Egyptians fit in a wider timeline of historical eras. Children will learn about what life was like in Ancient Egypt, locate Egypt on maps and identify human and physical features including learning about rivers in geography.

The following mini-outcomes will focus on some key areas of Egyptian history:

- River Nile and its importance Geography, Art and English. Links to current global issues around the River Nile today
- Tutankhamun History and English
- Mummification, coffins and tombs History, Art, DT, Maths and Science

All of the learning produced as part of each of the mini outcomes will be presented at a Museum exhibition where the children will act as tour guides and lead visitors around the various exhibits.
