# Subject: History - Significant Individuals - Explorers

**Enquiry Question:** Who journeyed into the unknown?

**Disciplinary Concepts:** similarity and difference, significance **Substantive concepts:** endurance, exploration, commitment

## **Programme of Study Statements**

- The lives of significant individuals in the past who have contributed to national and international achievements. Some should be used to compare aspects of life in different periods (for example, Elizabeth 1 and Queen Victoria, Christopher Columbus and Neil Armstrong, William Caxton and Tim Berners-Lee, Pieter Bruegel the Elder and LS Lowry, Rosa Parks and Emily Davison, Mary Seacole and/or Florence Nightingale and Edith Cavell)
- events beyond living memory that are significant nationally or globally (for example, the Great Fire of London, the first aeroplane flight or events commenorated through festivals or anniversaries)

## **Disciplinary Knowledge**

- observe and use pictures, photographs and artefacts to find out about the past;
- observe or handle evidence to find answers to simple questions
- know there are different types of sources and evidence that can be used to help represent the past
- order dates from simple to latest on a simple timeline
- know and recount episodes from stories and significant events in history about the past on the basis of simple observations
- understand that there are reasons why people in the past acted as they did

## **Disciplinary Knowledge**

- to know who was Shackleton and where did he explore
- to know the dates of his expedition
- to understand the geographical details of Shackleton's expedition
- to understand the route Shackleton and his team took across Antarctica
- to know who Ibn Battuta was and why he is significant
- to know who Isabella Bird was and why she was famous
- to understand the qualities they shared to keep going through such hardship

#### **Prior Knowledge:**

- understand that people can possess extraordinary qualities of commitment
- understand the concept of a voyage or journey

• understand that different civilisations explored, invaded and settled in new lands (Yrs 5&6)
