

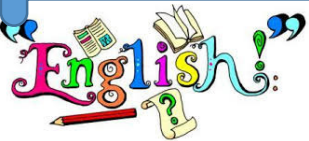


Maths

You are planning a sleepover with 4 of your friends. Your parents have given you £20 to spend. What will you buy?

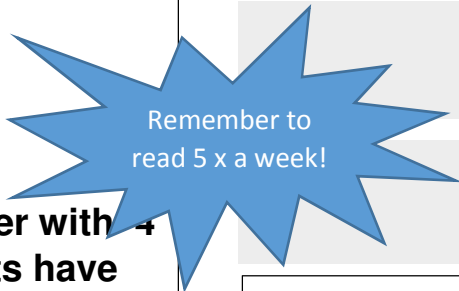
Make shopping list and find the cost of the items. Provide the costings and show how you have worked them out (no calculators). How near to spending the £20 can you get?

Write your own story where your main character is a giant and the main setting is Wickwar. You can magpie any ideas from the stories we have read this term or any other books which feature a giant in them.

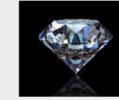
Can you fit in a hyperbole too ?

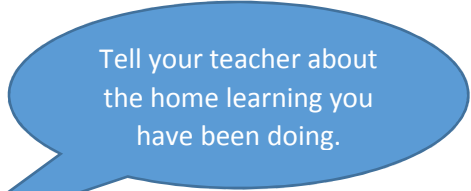

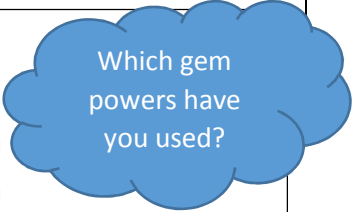
Term 4 – Due in by Wednesday 3rd April Choose any 2 of tasks.
