PWA – this week's session started with a group task .They had to problem solve to build structures using a limited amount of straws and blue tack . This linked really well to their recent DT learning on bridges and they were able to apply these skills to create their structures.



We have started our learning on decimals in maths and thank you for supporting your children with the pre learning set for half term . This has certainly helped them with the understanding of tenths and hundredths and linking this to fractions.

In English we are looking at the job of the pronoun in adding cohesion to their writing and have been revisiting grammar terminology and word sorting .Spellings for next week will be an assessment of the year 3 /4 spelling words .Children have now learnt most of these so I would like to see how many they have retained .

We have started looking at the city of Bristol as part of our Geography this term and have read the story of the Bristol Giants .
