We have continued to progress with place value by rounding numbers to 10,100 and 1,000. As an introduction, we went outside and formed human number lines and actively rounded up and down. The children enjoyed this very much and it certainly consolidated their initial understanding.



Our English grammar focus this week has been on using modifiers in front of adjectives. You may well have heard your child discuss this already at home as I have asked them to collect (magpie) any they find when they are reading and write them in the back of their reading record book.
