

In Science, we have been learning about how vertebrates and invertebrates are classified into many different groups based on their features. To apply our learning, we went outside to see what animals (mainly invertebrates) we could find to look at closely with magnifying glasses before creating classification keys to sort them based on their features and animal groups.



In maths, we have been finishing off our place value learning by: rounding numbers to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000, finding 10, 100 or 1000 more or less than a number and counting backwards through zero into negative numbers. Next week, we will be focusing on addition and subtraction.

In English, we have been building on our grammar and descriptive skills in preparation for beginning to write our own versions of our class story, Running Wild next week.

Next week, we will be trying out a TTRS practise multiplication check to give a starting point to work from and for children to experience what it will be like. TTRS will give them two Soundcheck games to play and will record the score of the last game.
