Maths:

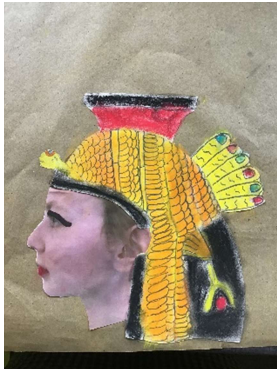
In maths we have continued to focus on all children being competent in addition and subtraction and have also extended this into reasoning about numbers too. Next week, we will be concentrating on consolidating written methods for multiplication and division so it would be helpful if you could remind your children to practise on TTRS in the coming days. We have also been learning about coordinates and how to plot them in a single quadrant and Miss Chalmers has extended this into looking at translating shapes too.

English:

We have focussed on refreshing some of our grammar knowledge and been applying our grammar skills to complete some grammar challenges. Overall, the children have been able to recall previous learning and just needed reminding of determiners and possessive pronouns again. We have started whole class reading of the Tutankhamun book in readiness for writing next week.

Art:

We have been looking at what Pharaoh's would have worn to represent their greatness and we tried to design an ancient Egyptian headdress. Do you recognise these Pharaohs?
