

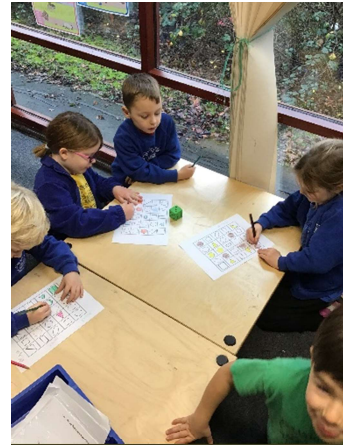


Emerald News
