



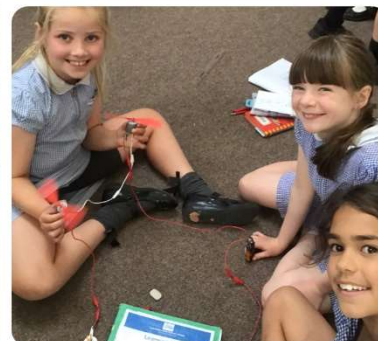
Diamond Class Newsletter
