We have been using our maths fluency skills for both addition and subtraction to solve number reasoning questions.

Example : correct /incorrect explain the mistake if there is one

8956 - 3649 = 5307

5632 - 3251 = 2281

4596 - 2657 = 1839

In English, we have been learning how to use fronted adverbials and a comma to develop different ways to open a sentence .We then looked at a video and read the book "The Tin Forest" which has a very strong environmental message and re-wrote the story proving that we were confident to apply our English grammar teaching.

We have been developing our map reading skills by using OS maps to answer the question: *Which woods are near to Wickwar?* Surprisingly, we located quite a few and used a key to then identify if they were coniferous /non coniferous, coppice or an orchard.
