Our learning: This week we have been applying our maths skills to solve a real life problem associated with Sports Day. Our challenge was to estimate and then work out how much squash would be needed for every child in Diamond Class to have a cup each. The children were given a budget of £2.50 and had to decide if this was going to be enough money or not. The challenge required the children to link conversion of measures, knowledge of fractions and money calculation. Most groups chose to practically measure out amounts and use pictorial representations to help solve the problem.
