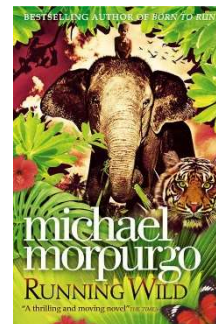


Diamond Class Newsletter

Coming up next week - Learning	Way to support at home
<p>In Maths this term we are focusing on place value, addition and subtraction methods and times tables. Next week we will be focusing on the place value of 4-digit numbers and partitioning them in different ways.</p> <p>In English, we will be reading a picture book called 'The Phone Booth in Mr Hirota's Garden' which tells the story of a tsunami hitting a village and the impact. We will then use this to learn more about tsunamis.</p> <p>We will be beginning to learn more about where the world's rainforests are located.</p>	<p>Read at least 5 times a week. Please ensure reading is recorded in the reading record books each week. These will be checked on Fridays</p> <p>Mathletics – new activities, linked to the learning we have been doing in class, will be added and checked every Tuesday.</p> <p>TTRS – we will be learning our remaining times tables this year and as the Multiplication Check will take place in the summer, regular practise is vitally important.
