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This week the aim was to develop behaviours that enable positive teamwork through these two activities. The second activity, Hoverball was designed to use many skills including teamwork, resilience and self-control. The task was to move a ball from point A into a bucket using the equipment of a ring with strings attached. They soon figured the solution but completing it was hugely challenging and at times very frustrating. Afterwards, the children were able to reflect on the activity and discuss how they could have improved on their team work skills.

Bikeability training started on Monday for the first group and the children learnt essential skills of how to control their bikes and how to ride safely. They worked hard and thoroughly enjoyed the session. The next two groups are now eagerly awaiting their turn.



We continue learning about fractions and are exploring equivalence using the fraction walls. We have focussed on visualising what equivalence looks like and have also used practical resources too. Please continue to support your child with Mathsletics homework as this will be both pre and post learning in this area.

In science, we have posed questions, planned and carried out investigations on how to change solids into liquids and we have learnt about the changing states of water during the Water Cycle. Key vocabulary has been: evaporation, condensation and evaporation.
