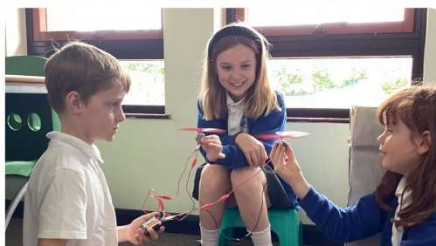
Multiplication Check
