<u>Computing</u>

Following on from the Aardman workshop, we wanted to animate our models using the software package" Zu3D". We had already explored animation using the Learnpads and moveable pictures on a background so our next step was 3D animation.

We had great fun creating our own scenarios, taking several pictures to slow down our character's movements and even adding in some sound effects ! The children have now taken these models home to make up their very own animations over the half term holiday .



Cross Curricular Maths and Science

We have continued to explore food chains in more depth and have linked this into learning how to organise information on a Caroll Diagram .The children have been super curious too and have posed some interesting questions like :
