Our learning:

English

We started our English this week by planning our narrative based on the story structure of Hugo Cabret . After having planned our setting, characters , order of events , and looked at our WAGOLL to understand what to include , we have finally started to write our first few paragraphs.

Maths

We have now moved onto investigating decimals and we have focussed on understanding the relationship between tenths 1/10 and hundredths 1/100 and how this is written in decimal notation 0.1/0.01. We have used place value grids and pictorial representation to help us understand this concept. Next week we will be moving on to dividing decimals by 10 and 100.

Science

Our Science has had a biology focus and we have researched information about our teeth .Our learning was very much helped by the pre learning you supported your children with over half term – thank you . All this week the children have been collating this information and shaping it into an information text . As a prelude to looking at the digestive system and to assess what the children already know, I asked them to work in groups to draw around each other and then draw in where they thought the digestive sytem was in their bodies .They then presented this to the class before comparing it to a correct picture . We had some very interesting ideas and diagrams!
