

This week in Maths we have been focusing on understanding place value, ordering and comparing 4digit numbers. To challenge ourselves we have been trying to place numbers accurately on a number line, considering scale.

Next week we will be rounding numbers to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000.



In English, we have been writing newspaper reports about Harry Potter going to Hogwarts. We have had fun exploring language effects in headlines and have been working hard to write in the correct style for a newspaper.

For one of our projects we will be drawing and painting our own selfportraits to display around the classroom like in the Hogwarts corridors. To begin this, we have been working on drawing the different features of the face using shading to create tone.
