



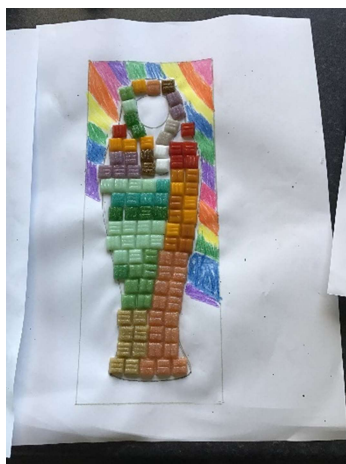
# Diamond Class Newsletter



This week in English we have been focusing on complex sentences, identifying the main and subordinate clauses and writing our own using varied conjunctions. We have also been writing persuasive adverts for the 'Tutankhamun Experience' from our class book 'The Ancient Egypt Sleepover'.

In maths we have been learning about tenths and hundredths and how these are represented as decimals. We have been representing decimal numbers in different ways.

For our art and DT project, we have been making cardboard sarcophaguses, applying knowledge of nets of 3D shapes. On the lids, we have designed mosaics and used tiles to create the final piece. Next week, we will be finishing these with additional hieroglyphs to try to replicate some of the Egyptian coffins we saw at the museum.



## Coming up - Learning
