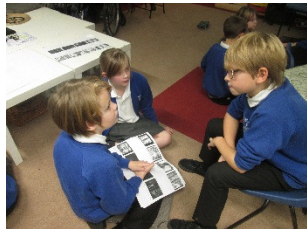
This week in Diamond Class:
