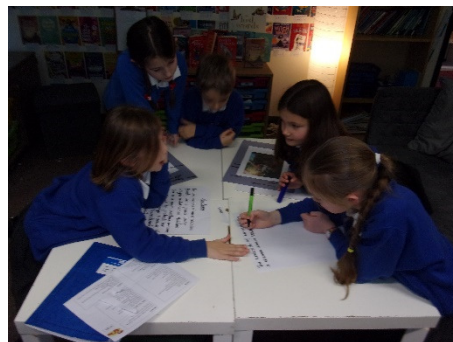
This week we have continued our learning on fractions and have been consolidating our understanding of fractions being divided in equal parts using apparatus and diagrams to help us. An example you can try is:

Tim has 16 sweets

He gives $\frac{1}{4}$ of them to his sister and $\frac{2}{4}$ of them to his mum.

How many does he have for himself?

In English, we have concentrated on developing descriptive vocabulary relating to dragons and have worked in groups to shape a descriptive text. The children will use this learning as a WAGOLL for their own writing next week. You may like to ask them if they can remember any of the higher-level vocabulary they have learnt.
