



This week in maths we have been continuing our place value learning, focusing on rounding numbers to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000. We have also been learning about Roman numerals.

In English we have been looking at building sentences, recognising the word class of the different parts of the sentence e.g. noun, verb, adverb, adjective, prepositions...



To help us to improve and secure fluency in arithmetic skills and times tables, we have introduced a new morning maths routine. First, we complete 4 or 5 arithmetic questions called 'Fluent in Five' and then go into Ashley Down Times Tables where we focus on one times table for a set number of weeks, embedding a small amount of times tables facts at a time. We are currently working on our 3x table and it is already making a big difference to fluency and accuracy.
