ART – Local artist study – Ruth Molley

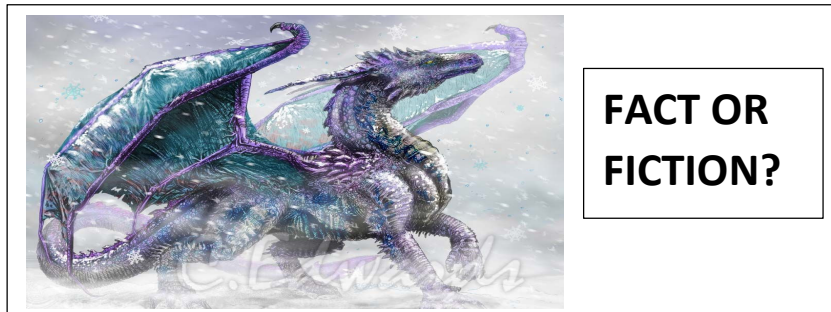
HISTORY – Local history is investigating the legend “The Giants of Bristol “
