## **Emerald Class Newsletter:**

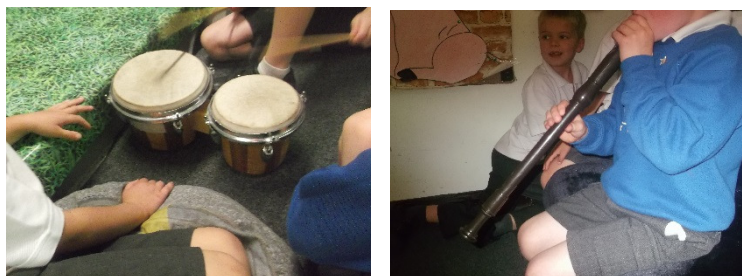
Just to let you know that we have not set any spellings this week and we shall not be setting for the last couple of weeks of the term. During this time, we will take the opportunity to look at personal misconceptions in the children's writing and tackle them in class. We have already been learning the year 2 spellings as we are a cohort of good spellers however I shall send a copy of these spellings home over the summer just to keep those spellings fresh in the children's heads so they can start year 2 ahead of the game.

### **This week:**

The children have been writing their own fairy tales, coming up with all kinds of goodies and baddies. It is wonderful to see their imaginations at work. We have a range of trees that come alive, circle monsters to a couple who go to the pub and meet a dragon... Either way, all the stories are very entertaining!

In Maths, we have been recapping measurement and shape. The children have been problem solving and developing their understanding of the language of measurement. It is very tricky when you are 6 and trying to compare cm, ml and grams as different ways to measure.

In their projects, the children have been looking at how music conveys emotions and personalities. The children have been listening to music and drawing pictures from their imagination of the picture the music sets in their heads. We have also looked at other ways we create goodies and baddies with the use of pencil lines, shape, colour and facial expressions.



We have also been investigating instruments. The children were attempting to make sounds, which represented fairy tale characters.
