This week:

We have been remembering to apply our spellings to our writing. The children have been working on correctly adding spellings with 'un' and 'es' such as unkind and houses. The children have been using this to write about fairy tale lands. We have also started to apply all of our skills to writing our own made up Fairy Tales. We have also written diaries from the point of view of Little Red Riding Hood or the Big Bad Wolf.

In Maths, we have been recapping shapes and we have learnt how to measure capacity and weight. Children have also shown creativity in linking their thinking to Fractions.

We have written plant reports, drawn and classified plants and we have made scientific observations as to how plants grow. The children have also been learning street dance. I have some excellent dancers... they certain put their teacher to shame with their amazing dance moves.
