It's been another busy week in Emerald class!

On Monday morning we started our week out on the field for a cricket session led by a coach from Gloucestershire cricket. We practiced different throwing and catching skills as well as learning some fun new games to play together.



In **Art** we have been learning to create a wash background using watercolour paints. We tried a block colour and a fade/ombre wash. Next week we will be creating our final pieces combining all the skills we have been learning.

In **Maths** we have been learning the column method to solve addition problems. We have built up our skills starting the week with 3 digit + 1 digit, all the way up to 3 digit + 3 digit questions. We have begun to look at subtraction and will continue with this next week before we start to learn about carrying over tens.



In our **Mental Maths** sessions we have been focusing on multiples of 3s this week. Many of the children would benefit from some focus on these using Time Table Rock Stars. If you click on the 'Jamming' section when you log in you can select which table you would like to focus on.

In **English** we have been writing non-chronological reports about Edward Jenner, who we have been learning about in our History lessons. The children have enjoyed researching and finding out lots of information and I have been impressed with the knowledge that is coming through in their writing so far.
