This week:

We have been looking at our verbs (doing words) and learning what they look like in a sentence. The children enjoyed acting it out and the writing sentences where they needed to find the verb in their sentences.

In Maths, the children have been reasoning their understanding of place value. They are understanding that a number such as '12' does not simple consist of a one and a two. They have been looking at the value behind them and reasoning why certain representations of numbers is incorrect.

The children have also enjoyed hearing and seeing photos of animals from my adventures and they have now drawn their own imaginary animal which they are writing about, applying varied adjectives to describe it.

In RE, the children have been learning bible stories and acting them out. The children loved finding and acting out the moral of the story.

We shall begin to plan out our non chronological reports about our imaginary animals as well as looking at ways to problem solve and reason how we find more and less than a given number.
