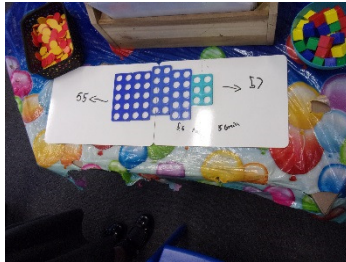
Emerald Class Newsletter:

This week:

We have broke ground with our Christmas performance. The children have been learning the songs for 'Donkey for sale' and speaking parts have now been handed out. It would be wonderful if you could help your child to practise their songs and their lines... thank you.

In English, we have been applying our 'er' and 'est' suffixes, writing comparisons between the 4 main up characters. We have also learnt about Proper nouns and how when else we are able to use capital letters. The children have also been applying this skill into their writing.

In Maths, the children have been problem-solving and reasoning when finding one more and one less. They have looked at the different ways in which they can show representations of numbers and then demonstrate how to make one more and one less. We have also been recapping our mental methods of our number bonds.
