

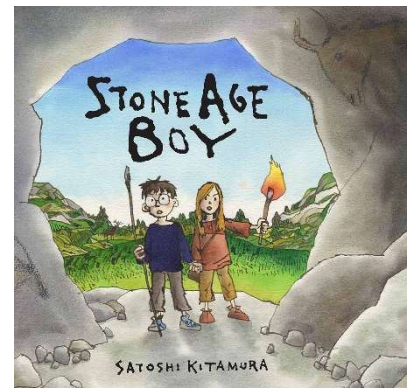


Emerald News

The new term started with our **WOW day** to launch our new project, *What was it like?* Where will be learning all about the Stone Age through to Iron Age. For our wow day we enjoyed an informative workshop from St Fagans Museum, made charcoal cave art and created a mini settlement of roundhouses and tepees using clay and natural resources found outside. In **English** this week have read our new text *Stone Age Boy* and have been thinking about the authors word choices and there meanings. We have written setting descriptions focusing on expanded nouns and have been revisiting our understanding of apostrophes for contraction.



In **Maths** we have started our learning around shape, using mathematical language to describe the properties; vertices, sides, angles, parallel lines and lines of symmetry. We have been working on our ruler skills to draw more accurate shapes and even had a go at using compasses to draw circles.

In **Science** we are learning about forces and had great fun investigating push and pull forces this week. We undertook investigations to find who's shoe had the best grip by either, using Newton metres to measure the pulling force, or by sliding our shoes down a table to see who's took the longest time to fall.
