



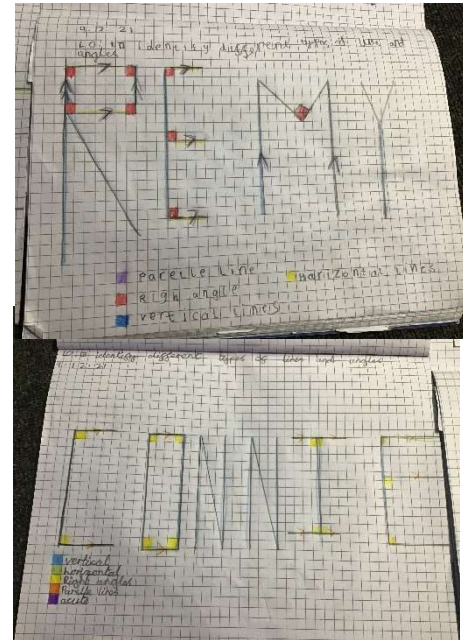
# Emerald News
