

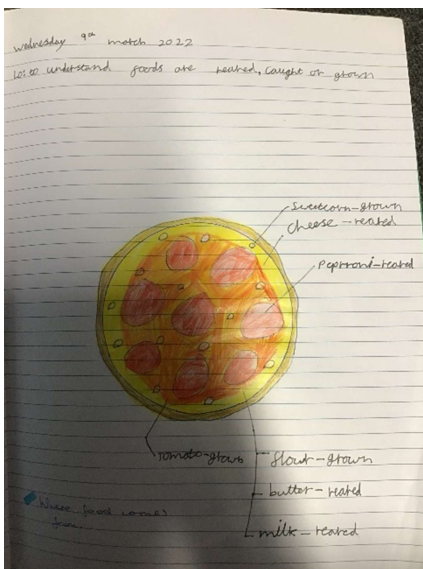
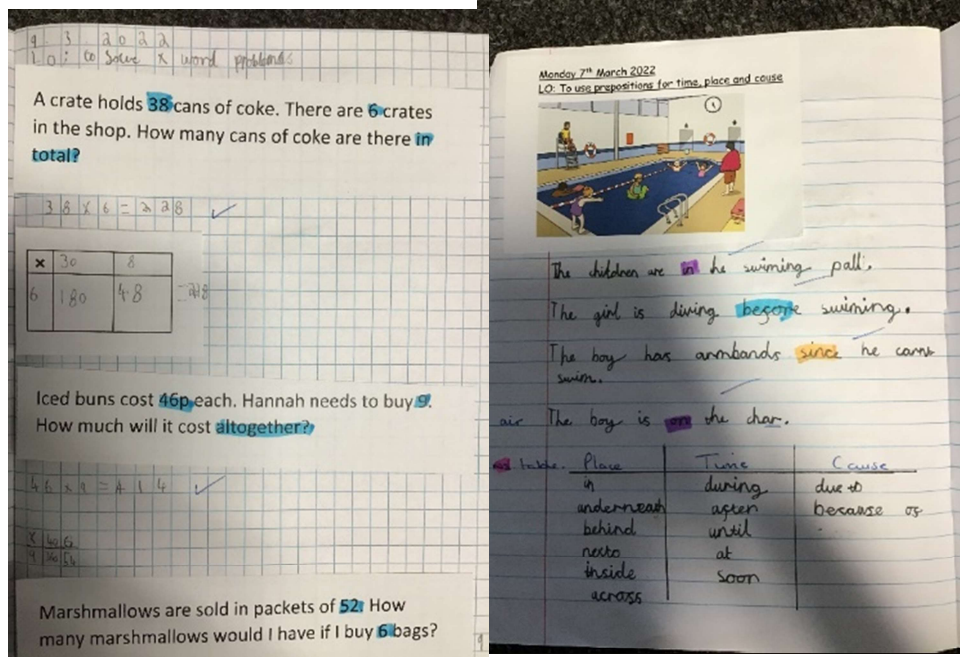


Emerald News

In **Maths** we have continued our learning about multiplication and have been beginning to use the grid method to solve 2digit x 1digit multiplication questions. We have begun our learning about division and will continue with this next week.

Don't forget to access **TTRS**; good multiplication fact recall is so important to support this learning!

In **English** we have been enjoying reading more of our story, The Boy Who Grew Dragons. We have recapped prepositions this week and applied these in a piece of narrative writing about the chase between the dragon and Tomtom the cat.



In **DT** we learnt about where foods come from and discussed that all foods are either reared, caught or grown. We thought about all the ingredients needed to make pizzas and which category they would be in. In **Jigsaw** we continued our learning about balance and making healthy choices by looking at the different levels of energy, sugar and salt in foods by reading the traffic light information on products. In **Geography** we looked closely at Europe and used our compass skills to name different countries North, East, South and West of others. We began to use more specific compass directions eg. North East and will build our atlas skills in the coming weeks.
