We have started planning our Non-chronological report. The children have seen some examples of Steve Backshall's deadly 60 program and we have learnt about the type of information needed for us to be able to write a non-chronological report about our own animals. In order to make sure that our writing is at its very best, we have been learning alongside our learning buddy who has helped us to check through each of our sentences for those vital full stops and capital letters.

In Maths, the children have enjoyed finding the parts and whole of 2 digit numbers. Not only did they use their place value to support their learning but they then reasoned their thinking to explain how they knew it was correct. This learning then helped them to problem-solve. The children have been helping Russell to find out where his dog food order went wrong... silly Russell!

We have now designed our bird feeders and the children are incredibly excited to start making them. We did realise that in order to make them, we would need to follow a set of instruction and so the children have been writing instructions and measuring cm with tape measures to ensure that their birdfeeders are accurate.
