


In **Maths** we have started our learning about multiplication by recapping the methods we can use to solve multiplication questions. We enjoyed making links between tables we know and multiples of 10, realising that as we know our 4 x table we also know our 40 x table. We will be applying these skills to solve more complex multiplication questions next week.

In **English** we have started our new text 'The Boy Who Grew Dragons' by Andy Shepherd and have enjoyed making predictions and discussing the pros and cons of having a pet dragon.



In **DT** this term we are learning about healthy and varied diets which links closely to our **Jigsaw** puzzle piece, Healthy Me.
