We've had a very busy week in Emerald class getting to know each other and finding out about some of the things we will be learning in Year 3.

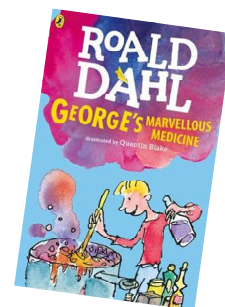
