This week:

Emerald class have been learning about exclamation marks. We have learnt when to use them and how to read them with impact. We have applied our understanding of exclamation marks to our writing. In English, we have also been preparing for story writing. The children have written their plans and acted out the story, each group took a part of the story. We focused on clarity of voice and facial expressions.



In Maths, we have looked at how we can apply our knowledge of adding and number bonds to support our mental maths and we have solved various problems for Peter Pan, Tinker Bell and Captain Hook...Its surprising how much they need Emerald classes help. We have also moved onto subtraction which we shall be continuing next week with reasoning and problem solving.
