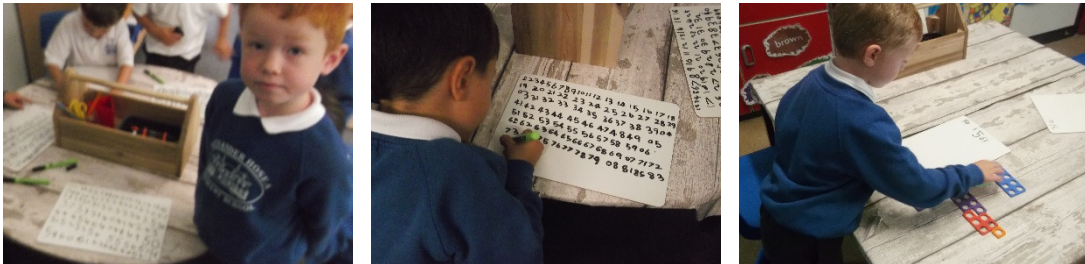
Welcome to Emerald Class Newsletter:
