

This week the children have been writing setting descriptions using their senses with and' as a focus in their sentences. The children have also started designing their own badges to go on their own the bears they sew later on in the term. The badges are linked to what makes them unique.

In maths we have focused on quarters of shape, objects and numbers. This has linked to division, we have used a drawing method to show the groups we are sharing into e.g. 8 shared by 2.
