What have we been learning?

This week the children have learnt the history of Philip Astley and have written brilliant fact files about him. Ask your child all about him.

The children have also created collages of clowns using scrunching, folding, tearing and cutting.

We have explored length and height so it would be great if at home you discuss different items or people that are long, tall, short, big or small. Also we have investigated materials in the classroom and trying to understand the difference of materials and objects. Another discussion at home about what different things are made of would be very helpful for the children's understanding.

In maths this week the children have been introduced to the symbol for multiplication and have looked into finding out different ways of representing a calculation.

$$2 + 2 + 2 = 3 \text{ groups of } 2 = 3 \times 2 = 6$$
