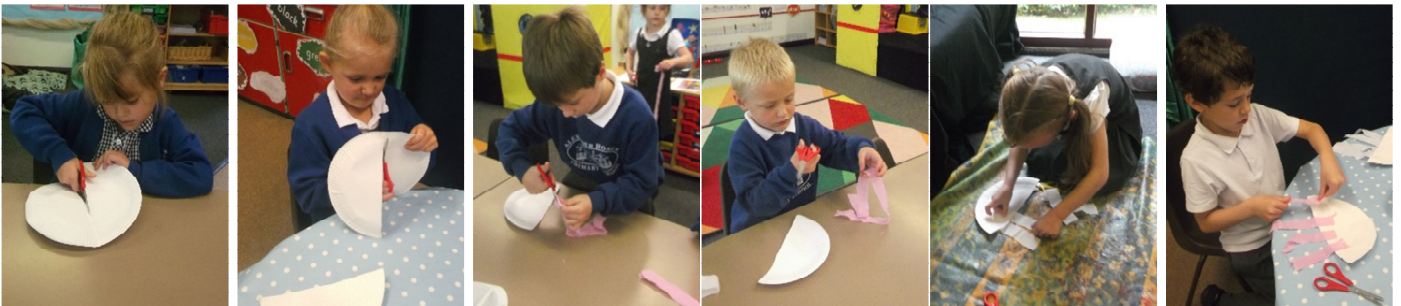


### What have we been learning?
