What have we been learning?

This week the children applied their knowledge of the spelling rules we have learnt over the weeks, -er, -est, -ed, -s and -es to help the jugglers get a part in the circus. The children described what Jon looked like and what he liked or disliked.



We discussed what it might be like for the animals in the circus and the children decided they wanted to help the animals. They drew lion heads and have used mood colours with pastels to show anger and sadness for the mane. Also the children have used their skills to shade lines to create a cage effect using dark and light lines to stick the lion head onto.

In the home books the children's mathematics usernames and passwords have been stuck in to start practising maths skills and gaining coins at home! Enjoy!
