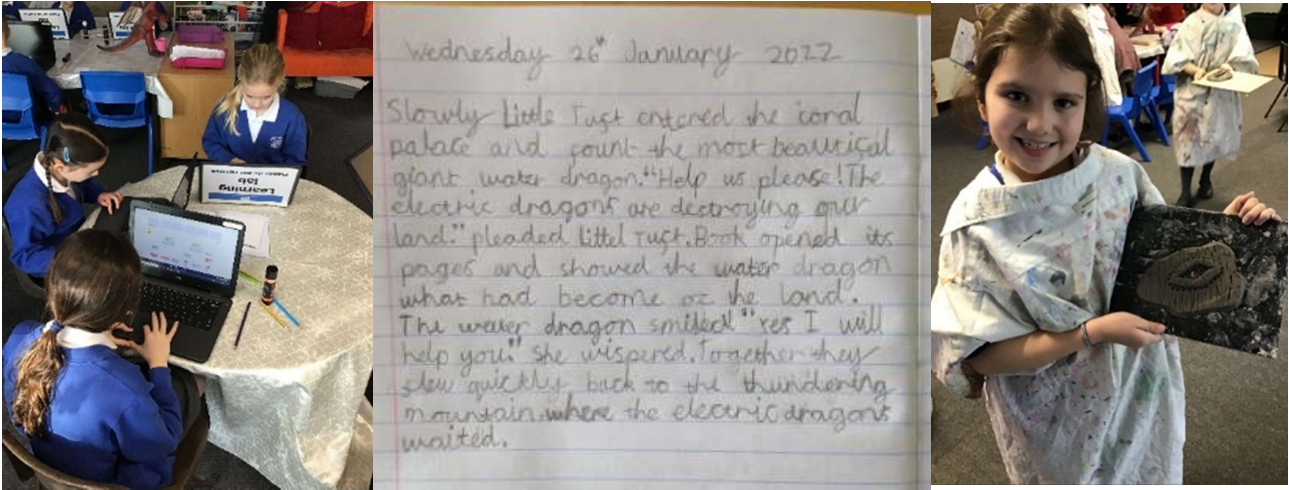




Emerald News

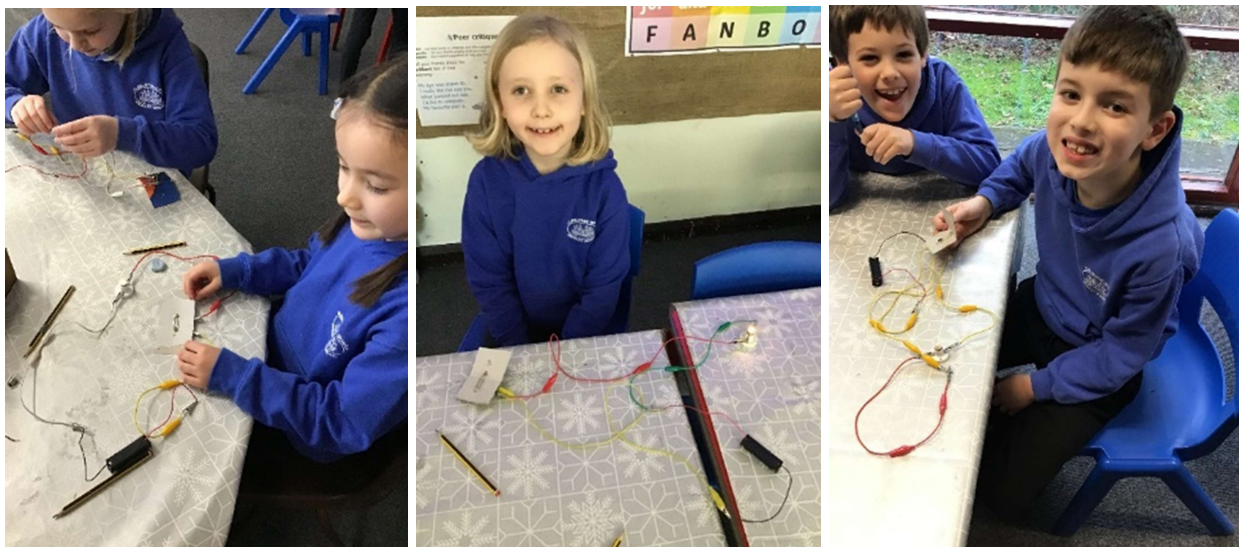
