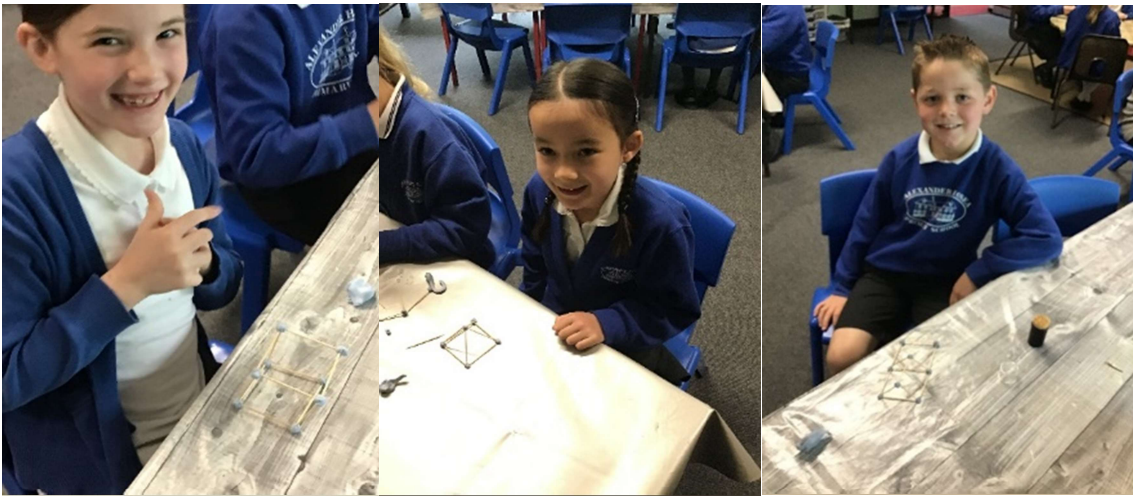




Emerald News
