

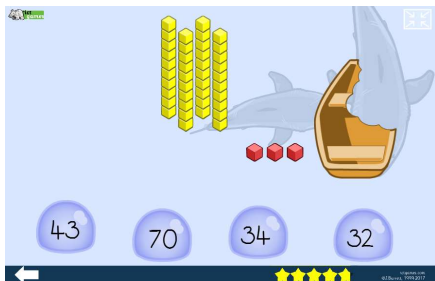


Emerald News
