This week:

Emerald class have been learning about compound words. The children have played matching games as well as applying these to their writing where they have been writing a description of Neverland.

In Maths, we have continued to look at different ways to add including on a number line and by bridging. This children have found this challenging and it will be helpful for them to practise the method for home-learning so we can try to move this method from written to mental.

In our projects, we have started to look at the Great Fire of London. The children have looked at picture sources and have tried to deduce what life was like back in 1666. The children made comparisons with our current London skyline and recognised that people back in 1666 didn't have any electricity or cars back then. Have a look for yourselves.
