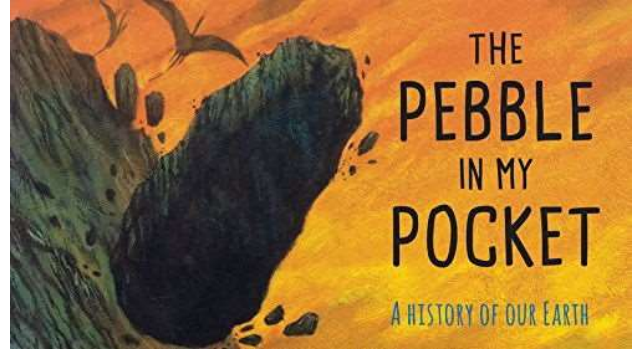




# Emerald News

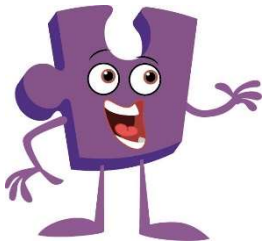
We've had a lovely first week back for term 6!
