This week:

We have been writing more great descriptions about our imaginary animals we would like to see on our adventures. The children have been applying more relevant adjectives as well as trying to extend our sentences with 'and' 'but' and 'because'.

In Maths, we have been comparing numbers, using the mathematical language of 'more than' 'less than' 'least' and 'most'. The children started with equipment to show the differences and this has led to more written comparisons where we are just looking at numbers. Some of the children have tried to reason their understanding of why one number is bigger than another.

We have also been writing Scientific questions to find out more about our animals, thinking about what they eat and where they come from. The children have continued with their drama with Mrs Gee – we have some amazing actors and actresses.
